I discussed the Capital budget requests we will be asking for. Mini van, playground equipment

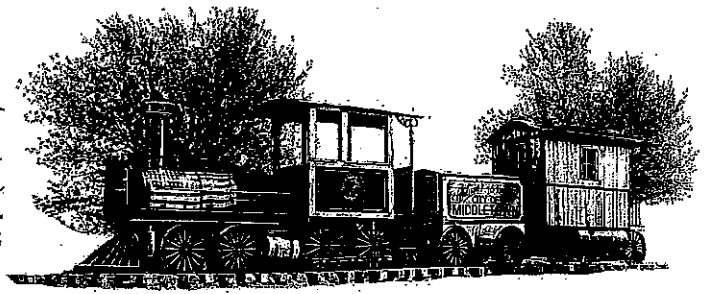
and resurfacing of courts. John Bianchi will also be putting in for equipment.
