We spoke further about getting pur information out. We will look into having a table at the Wednesday Family Nights. We will also look into getting four fliers out digitally in the morning announcements at schools.

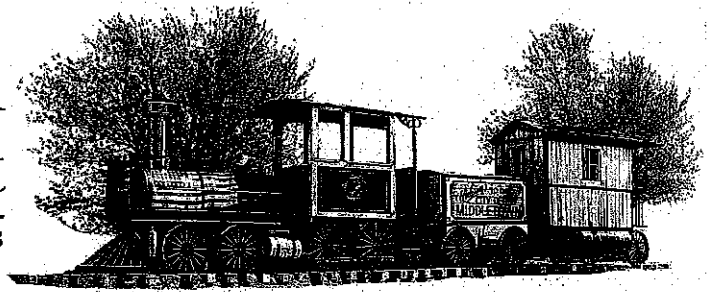
Announcements

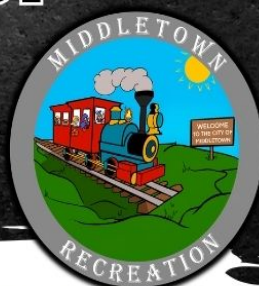
